

# Create .CHD From .CUE Files

## Windows

[cue2chd.bat](#)

```
for /r %%i in (*.cue) do chdman createdc -i "%%i" -o "%~ni.chd" >> log
```

## Linux

[convertFromCueToChd.sh](#)

```
parallel chdman createdc -i {} -o {}.chd ::: *.cue
```

The below script and the attached version above does not work. Need to test and change accordingly.

```
#!/bin/bash

# Grab .cue file
for f in ./**/*.cue
do
  name=${f%.cue} # Remove '.cue' from file name
  chdman createdc -i "$name.cue" -o "$name.chd" --force
done
```
