## Windows

[chd2cue.bat](#)

```
for /r %%i in (*.chd) do chdman extractcd -i "%%i" -o "%~-ni.cue" >> log
```

## Linux

[convertFromChdToCue.sh](#)

```
#!/bin/bash

# Grab .chd file
for f in ./**/*.chd
do
  name=${f%.chd} # Remove '.chd' from file name
  chdman extractcd -i "$name.chd" -o "$name.cue" --force
done
```
